

# TEACH AN INTERSESSION CLASS AT E.L. HAYNES! [www.elhaynes.org](http://www.elhaynes.org)

E.L. Haynes is seeking current teachers/retired educators to lead week-long (approximately) **Fall Intersession** classes for students aged pre-kindergarten through sixth grade **during the weeks of October 13<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> (M-F)**. Intersession classes are offered throughout the year in four major sessions: two weeks in fall, one week in winter, one week in spring, and four weeks over the summer.

## QUALIFICATIONS

Qualified applicants will have at least a bachelor's degree and will have had past teaching experience—whether in a classroom setting, camp or after school setting where planning was required, or in an artistic setting (dance, drama, culinary arts, etc.). Pay is commensurate with experience. Other employment opportunities available during Intersession include Teaching Assistants, Interns (high school/college aged students seeking experience in education), and various volunteer opportunities.

## BACKGROUND

The E.L. Haynes Public Charter School Intersession Program is a unique opportunity for our students to more deeply explore new and engaging topics of interest. As E.L. Haynes operates on a modified (year-round) school calendar, Intersession programming is offered during our quarterly breaks. Ranging from one to four weeks in length (each week being its own session), Intersession provides students with additional opportunities to grow and learn. Each class focuses on a particular topic or area of interest (past examples have included studies of countries around the world, dance, art, film, camping, science, martial arts, photography, athletics/fitness etc.). The focus is the choice of the teacher, based on expressed areas of interest for our students. All Intersession classes incorporate literacy, math, science, social studies and visual /performance arts along with trips to conduct field work at museums, parks, and other venues relating to the topic being studied. Extensive planning is required and both templates as well as individual help are provided. Daily hours are 8am-4pm, with breaks provided as needed
