Teaching fellows work primarily with one classroom assisting with instruction and fully participating in the life of the classroom. Teaching fellows begin the year observing and assisting teachers and gradually assume more responsibility for planning and teaching as the year progresses. Teaching fellows have significant opportunities to learn from their classroom teachers and the entire Haynes staff. Teaching fellows also participate in professional development both at Haynes and outside of the school. Teaching fellows report to their classroom teachers. E.L. - ▶ Support the classroom teacher in planning and delivering effective differentiated instruction.

- ▶ Encourage family involvement.
- ▶ Assist in the monitoring of recess, field work, and outdoor activities to ensure student safety.
- ▶ Be an active member of the E. L. Haynes Professional Learning Community.
- ▶ Contribute to the productivity of the school as a whole
- ▶ Attend and participate in school events including quarterly curricula workshops for families.
- ▶ Teach a week-long Intersession class for an additional stipend, if desired.
